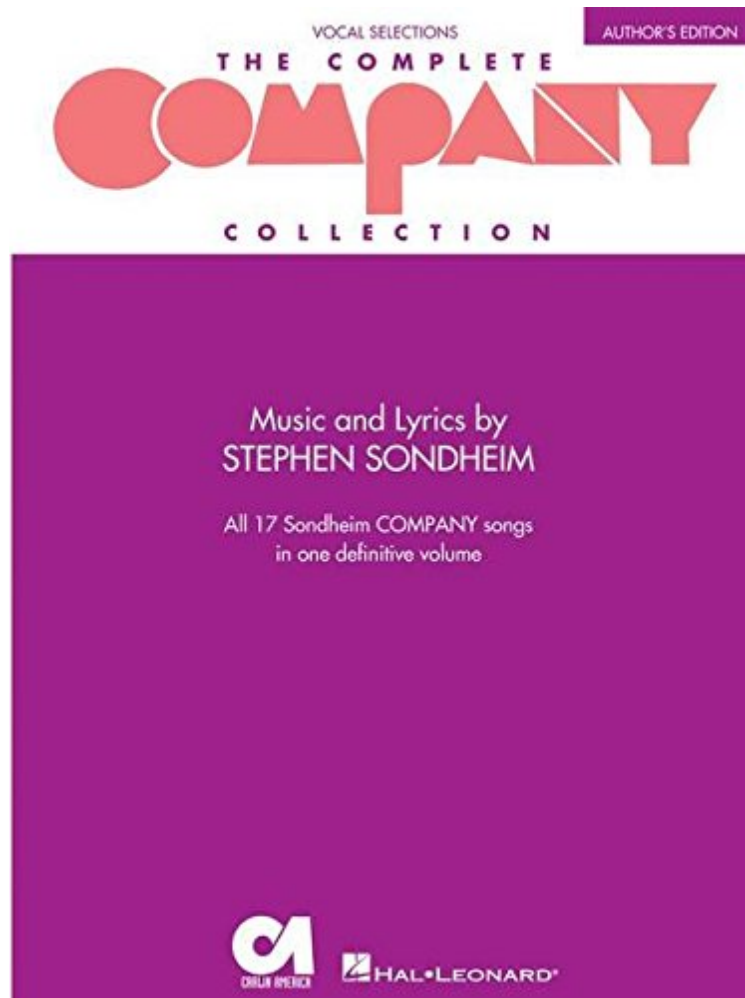

It's got a great, wide-ranging collection of songs about love, relationships, and searching for a connection, all crafted with Sondheim's signature wit and unique perspective and sound. My favorite is the classic "Ladies Who Lunch" originated by Elaine Stritch, though Barbara Walsh's rendition in the revival with Raul Esparza took my breath away. It's a sharp little number that's cutting and a little mean-spirited, but hiding more than a twinge of regret underneath. "Getting Married Today" is a fun little number, if you can master the breakneck speed! Carol Burnett did an amazing version of this on a TV special - if

you can find the video it's worth watching! It really captures all of the sweeping emotions you can feel when preparing for "the biggest day of your life" and all of the hype and stress that's built up around what should be a joyous celebration. "The Little Things You Do Together" is classic Sondheim quirkiness at it's best (Barbara Walsh's deadpan delivery while playing the triangle gets me every time!). Another favorite is "Marry Me A Little" that perfectly catches the longing for connection with a fear of losing one's individuality and freedom in a relationship.
