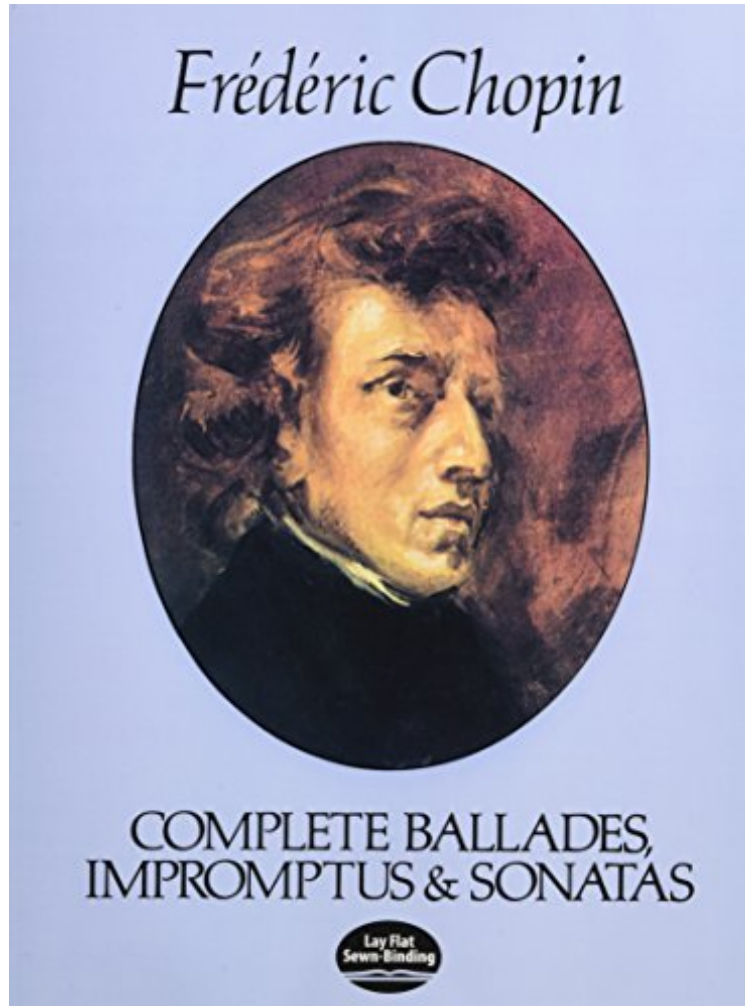

It even contains a foreword written by Carl Mikuli, one of Chopin's students, and later his teaching assistant, so he was in a position to know certain things about Chopin's playing and ability that perhaps few actually witnessed. He gives very valuable insight into Chopin's own ability, skills, and how he played his pieces. The music is rather large, and thus very readable. However, the binding is...well, I tried everything I could to find a spiral binding for this book and could not. I

honestly feel that all piano music should come in spiral-bound books because of the frustration inevitably involved with any music print in books other than spiral-bound. But, that is my only complaint, and thus not just specific to this book, but all non-spiral-bound music books. 11 of 11 people found the following review helpful. Not the Paderewski Edition By Katie I'm currently studying this piece, and bought this item, which looked just like my teacher's, only it's edited by Carl Mikuli instead of Paderewski. (both have the perry winkle front cover). There are significant changes in dynamics and articulation. I spent one week marking it up, only to find that my teacher is making me buy the other one - the Paderewski, and that edition's pages are thicker, darker, and less crammed onto the pages.
