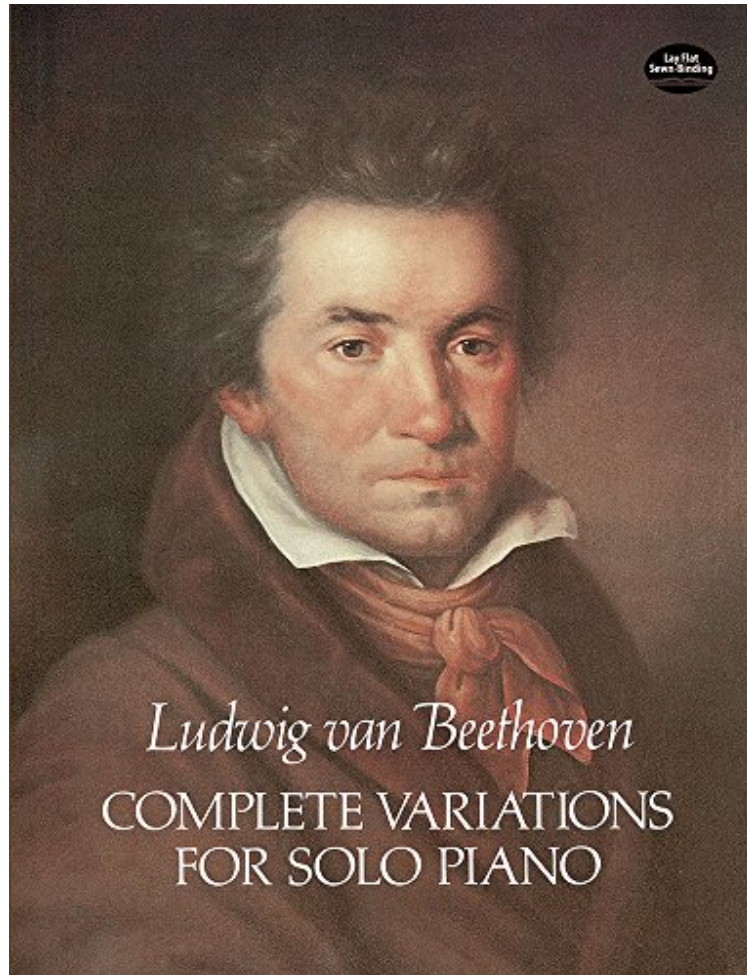

In fact, some of the works (e.g. the variations on God Save the Queen) are superb but are seriously underplayed. The 32 variations in c-minor are in there, as are the (very, very hard) Diabelli variations.
