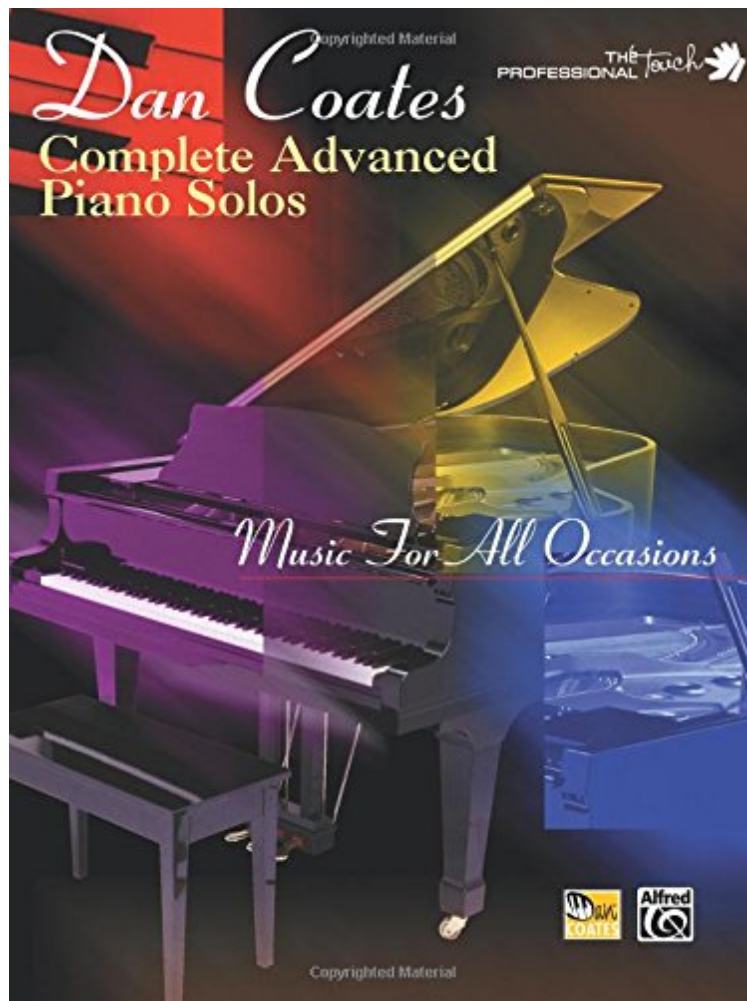

1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. Some strange song choices like Love and Marriage (really?) but I fell in love with his version of Over the Rainbow and had to have this book. I never heard of many of the songs, but each is nicely done. It's true, his pieces can get a little repetitive (different octaves), but they're so beautifully arranged that it's a joy to play them over and over. Some are more advanced (Star Wars, Ragtime) than others (Happy Birthday, The Prayer).  
 Caveat: I actually preferred Canon in D for his easy piano version better than in this book. Advanced is \*very nice\* also but I think sounded more traditional. I also wished he did some other pieces in his easy version in the advanced such as Bridge Over Troubled Waters and You Raise Me Up. That said, this is still one awesome compilation.
