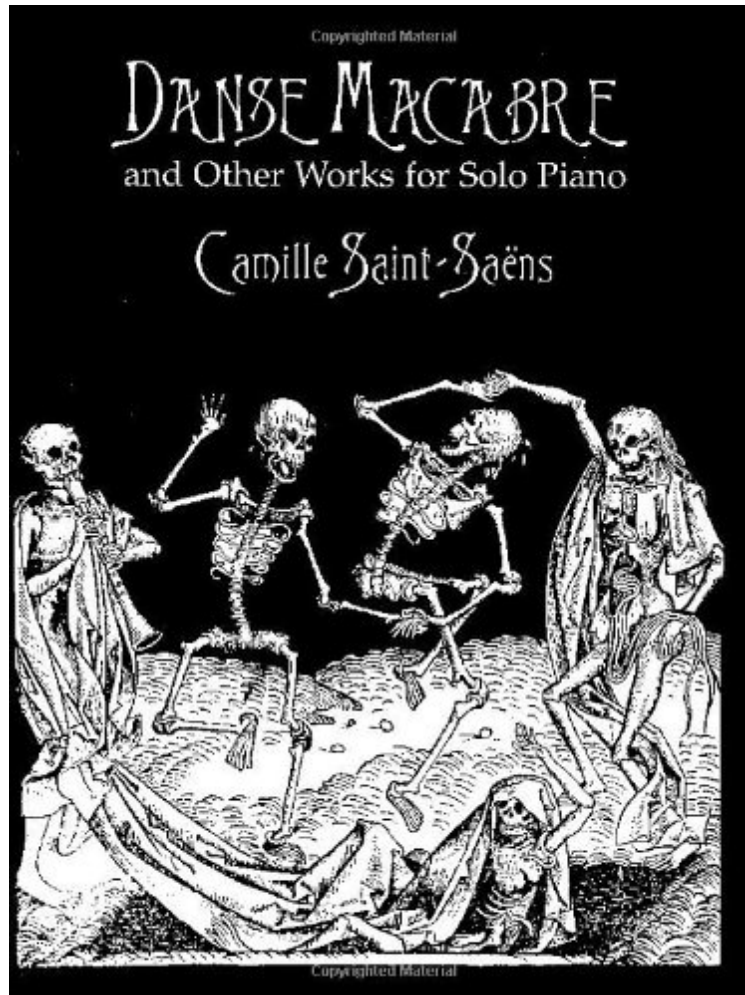

The passion and fury of these pieces are what made Saint-Sans' reputation as a master composer. A good book. Some difficult pieces, but when you've played them enough you too will have what Saint-Sans calls "l'indépendance des doigts" .. finger independence.
