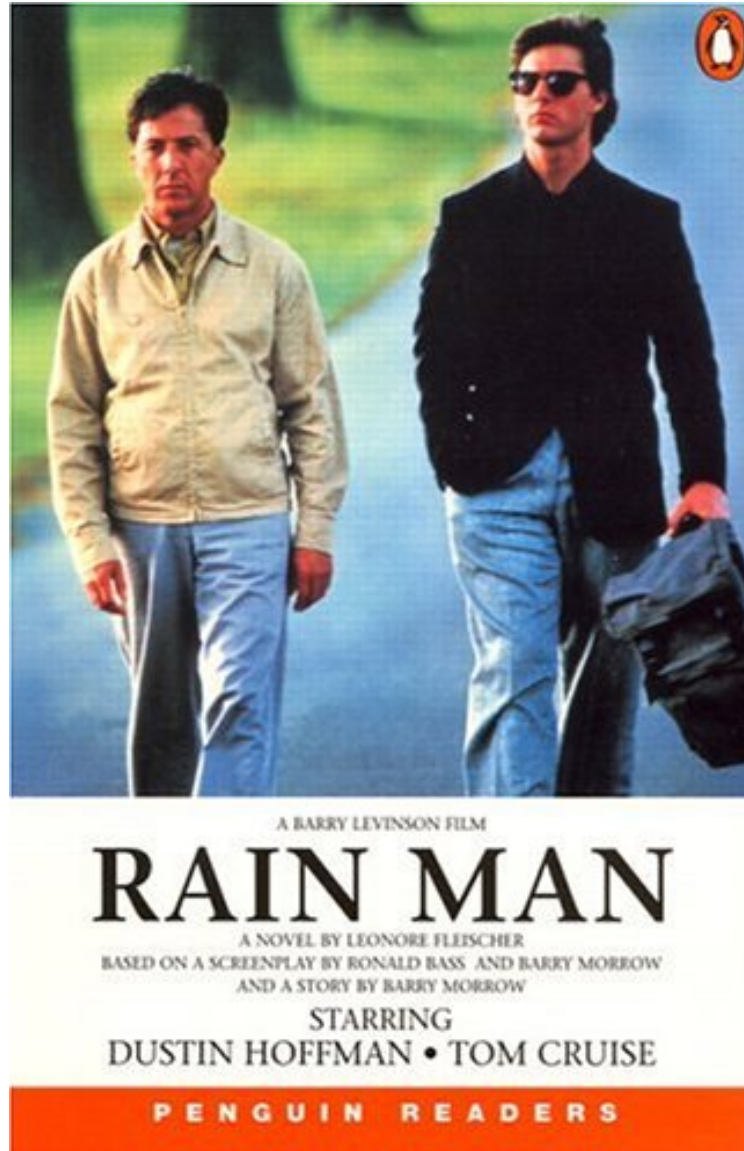

There is little to no description, although it's not absolutely necessary in novels, some of the descriptions are painstakingly wrong (the
