.com In terms of both style and content, Wired was so over-the-top to begin with that it seemed almost parody-proof. Yet several satiric homages have already appeared on the Web, and now comes a letter-perfect spoof from the creators of Is Martha Stuart Living?. It's all here: the impenetrable graphics, the cybermeditations by "John Barry Barleycorn," and an adoring profile of a 16-year-old Net-made millionaire. If the humor sometimes descends to geeky lows, well, Connor and Downey are merely being faithful to their source.
