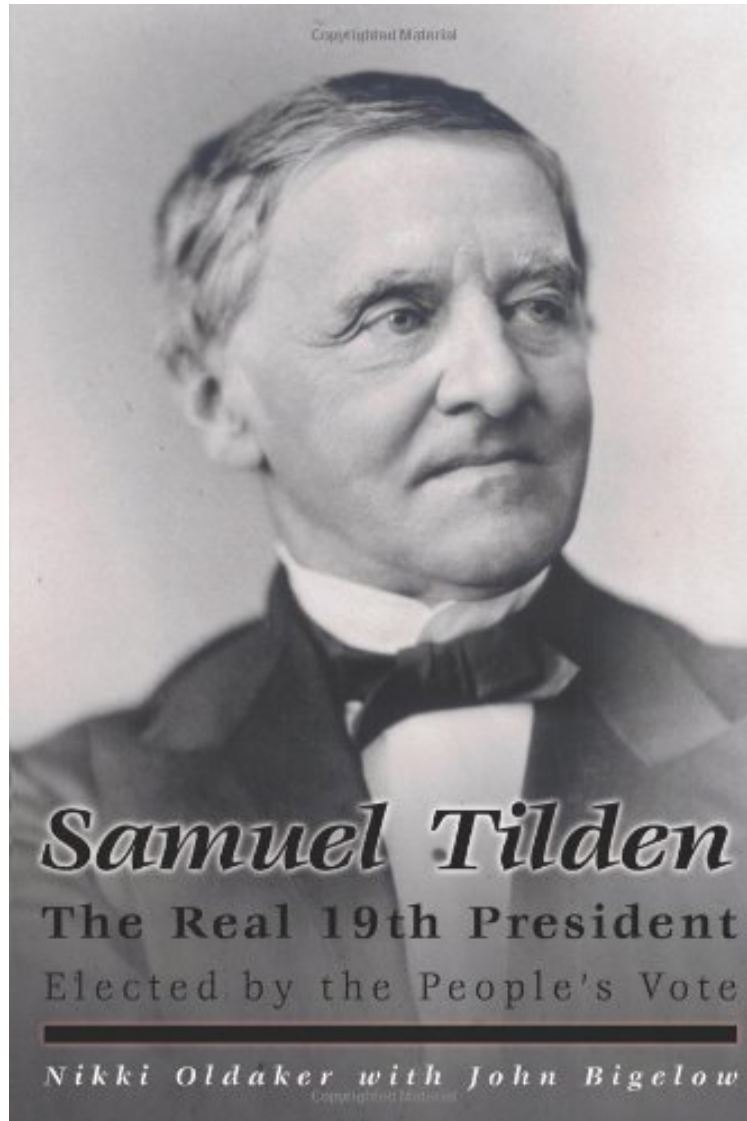

My expectation was that it would be written in the typical expository style of a David McCullah, or Barbara Tuchman. It has numerous typos and repeated sentences, probably due to poor editing. The author also needed to present the unraveling of a complicated event more clearly. I found myself reading passages without comprehending their meaning.
