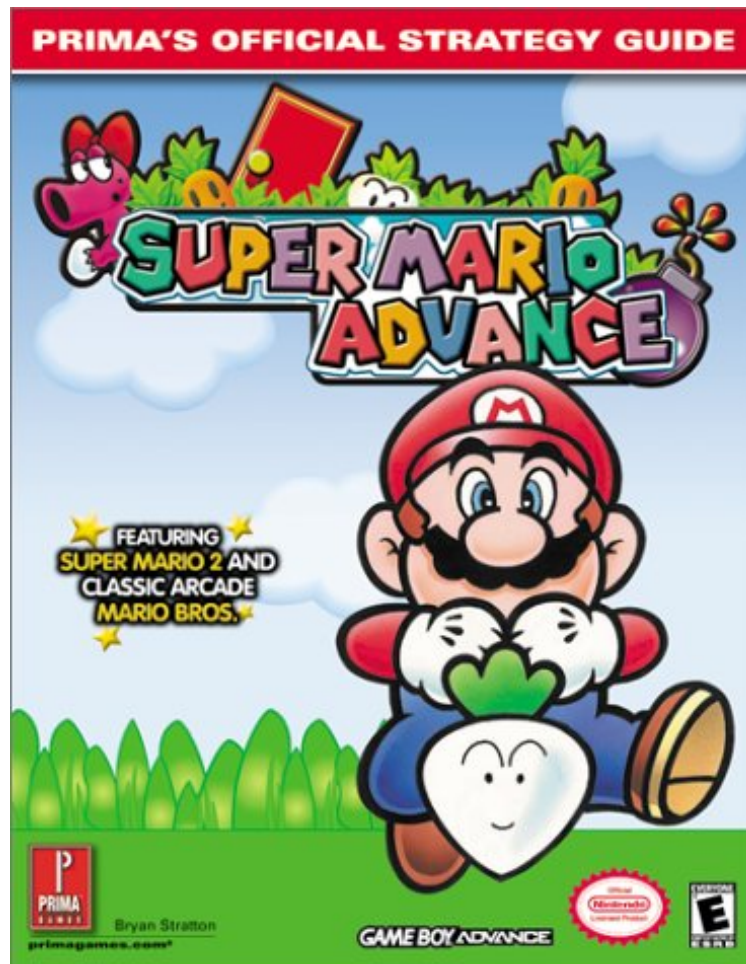

Decent strategy guide, but don't botherBy Mike London"Super Mario Advance", which is modelled after the sixteen bit version of the 1988 NES classic Super Mario Bros. 2, first published in 1993 in the Super Mario All Stars SNES compilation, is a basic platformer and is a very well known game. There are some minor level changes, voice acting, and the introduction of a new boss exclusive to this version called Robo-Birdo (who replaces the second Mouser fight from World 3-3). Given how well known the game is, and also how short too, not sure why you need to justify spending money on a game guide for it. While the game guide adequately covers its subject matter, there are NO maps of the original levels. Seriously?? If Nintendo can publish a superior two part guide (Super Mario Brothers 2 Inside Out [Nintendo Power]) that gives complete maps of every level back in 1989 as a FREE GIVE AWAY for those who were subscribed to Nintendo Power, then by God Prima

should be able to do the same thing in 2001/2002 when this was published?The guide does cover all Ace Coin and Yoshi egg locations, and tells you what happens if you collect them all. It also covers the basic move set of Mario, Luigi, Princess Toadstool, and Toad.This is from the publishing blurb:"Stats on all characters, enemies, and itemsLocations for Ace Coins, Magic Potions, power-ups, and hidden Mushrooms revealedTactics for winning every Bonus Chance Mini-GameDetailed strategies for all 7 WorldsStrategies for single-player mode for Super Mario 2 and both single- and multiplayer modes for Mario Bros."That's basically all true. The only potential bonus I see to this guide from people who grew up with the original NES version (like myself) or the SNES version is it does tell you the locations of the third mushroom that was added to each level (the original release only had two mushrooms total per level).The binding is good and the print quality fair.Overall, given how short this game is and how easy it is to master, just play the game. It's not like "Super Mario Bros 2" is a complex RPG - it's a 20 level platformer. Trust me, I love "Super Mario Bros. 2" but I don't really think this guide is necessary for most players. What made the walkthrough good was that they had a quick reference guide in the back and that was only to help you find mushrooms, ace coins, and yoshi eggs if you wanted to get through the level in a hurry. Crystal clear screenshots basically dominated.The secrets were well done while I still was able to find some tricks that I was stupidly trying out to see if they worked (and did but hey they were stupid), they actually told me what would happen if I got all the Ace coins in the game, they actually TOLD me what would happen if I collected all the yoshi eggs too.They completely covered the Super Mario Bros. classic very easily. The guide was so detailed. I have to recommend this guide out to anyone there is. While it still isn't the best its better than the other two I saw. Keep this in mind because the guide is very decent and well put together.
