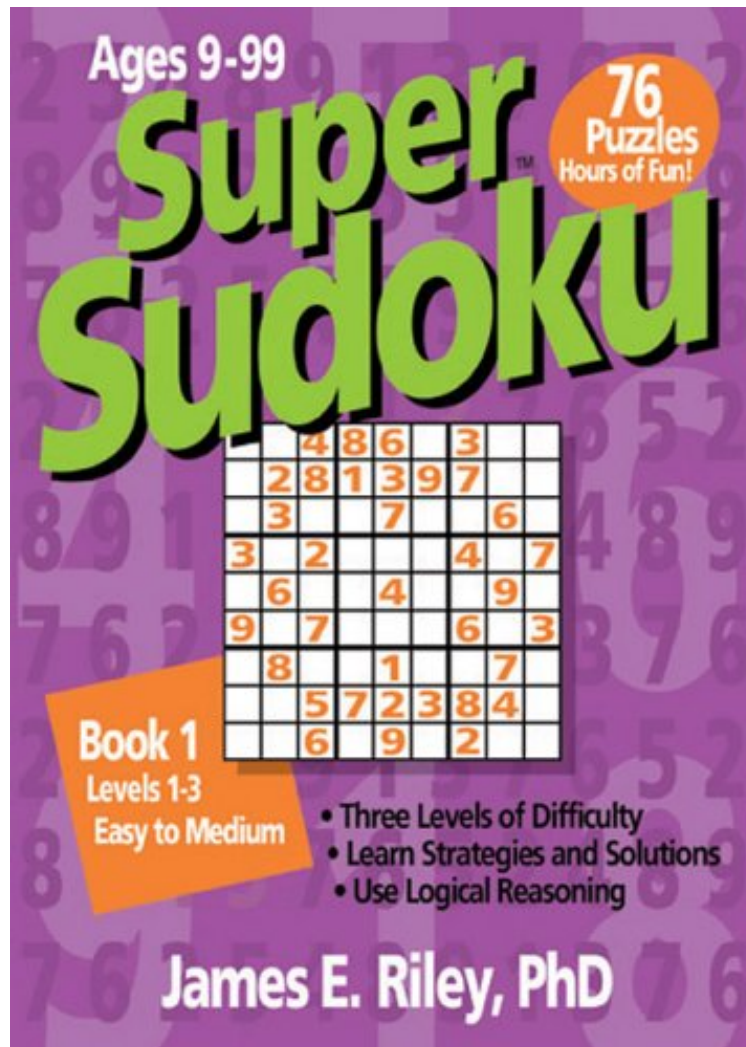

I can understand this advice for a crossword puzzle, but for a Sudoku puzzle, c'mon, Mr. Riley, really now. I love, love, absolutely love everything else about this Sudoku book. The paper the puzzles were printed on was right on. When you get into the more difficult puzzles you need to erase all the little clues you pencil in. If you find a book printed on newsprint, it's not worth the paper it was printed on and I mean that literally. This book has a very thick piece of cardboard in the back and opens from top to bottom like a steno notebook instead of from the side which makes it very easy to work on them anywhere even on the go.
