I imagine it is not hard to produce top quality duets when you have such excellent source material, but they certainly didn't botch it, each part has things to make it interesting all the way through. They are not beginner music, they are at the level of a Beethoven Sonata. I am not an expert at judging the difficulty of music (and different skills are learned in different orders), but if you can handle the Pathetique sonata, or the Moonlight Sonata, or Sonata op2 no3, you will be able to handle these. The main difficulty a pianist might find when picking these up is that timing is a lot more important than in many other duets. It is orchestral music, and sometimes it is hard to know when to come in so you need to count. You can't always figure out when to come in based on melody alone. If a person is not used to doing that, they will find it a bit of a challenge at first, but practice overcomes all challenges! 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
